Member Code of Conduct



The officials of Harford County Umpires Association (HCUA) are a group of individuals dedicated to the principle of excellence in officiating. To maintain a professional association, each umpire must be committed to the principles of the Code of Conduct listed below. All officials are expected to read, understand and carry out the responsibilities of this code.

As an HCUA Umpire working HCUA Games, I agree to...

- Enforce the rules and exercise authority in an controlled, firm and impartial manner.
- Continually strive to improve my umpiring capability.
- Be punctual, arriving at least 30 minutes of game time.
- Contact my partner for upcoming games, at least 24 hours before game time.
- Adhere to the HCUA's Uniform Policy by dressing appropriately and neatly before, during, and, after officiating games.
- Conduct myself in a manner consistent with the high standards of the officiating profession and of Harford County Umpires Association.
- Use tobacco/tobacco products only where designated.
- Refrain from officiating any game under the influence of drugs and/or alcoholic beverages.
- Address fellow umpires, participants, coaches, parents, tournament personnel, etc. in a respectful manner.
- Not openly criticize another Association member at any time, (except in private and for the purpose of aiding or evaluating an umpire).
- Adhere to HCUA's zero-tolerance policy regarding violence and harassment of any kind, towards any player, coach, spectator, fellow umpire, tournament personnel, etc.
- Abstain from any and all 'Prohibited Conduct' within HCUA's Social Media Policy.
- Comply with all HCUA Bylaws, and understand that my failure to comply with said bylaws could be grounds for discipline by the HCUA Judiciary Committee.
